## **INITIAL TEACHER TRAINING AT CRANLEIGH ABU DHABI**

### **INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES 2021-22**

Thank you for your interest in the University of Buckingham IPGCE course at Cranleigh Abu Dhabi. Here are a few key points regarding applications which you may find helpful.

- The number of places available for trainees is influenced by a range of factors and this year the number is likely to be particularly restricted.
- The course is run by the University of Buckingham, and your acceptance to train as a teacher is subject to satisfying the requirements of both the University and Cranleigh Abu Dhabi
- The course is full time for one year, and is funded by you, the student
- You are required to be at school full time during regular working hours (between 7.15 am and 3.30 pm Sunday to Thursday.)
- You will be required to attend pre-term training/meetings from 20th<sup>th</sup> August 2021.
- You may be required to attend training, meetings and other extra-curricular activities outside these hours
- It is not possible to complete the course at the same time as working elsewhere
- Successful completion of the course does not guarantee subsequent employment at Cranleigh Abu Dhabi
- Applicants should have a good Honours degree or equivalent in their subject specialism.
- If you are offered a place by Cranleigh, we would then begin the application process to Buckingham University
- You will be teaching lessons within the first few weeks of term, and will be responsible for planning, delivering and assessing work, in addition to holding a pastoral role in the school
